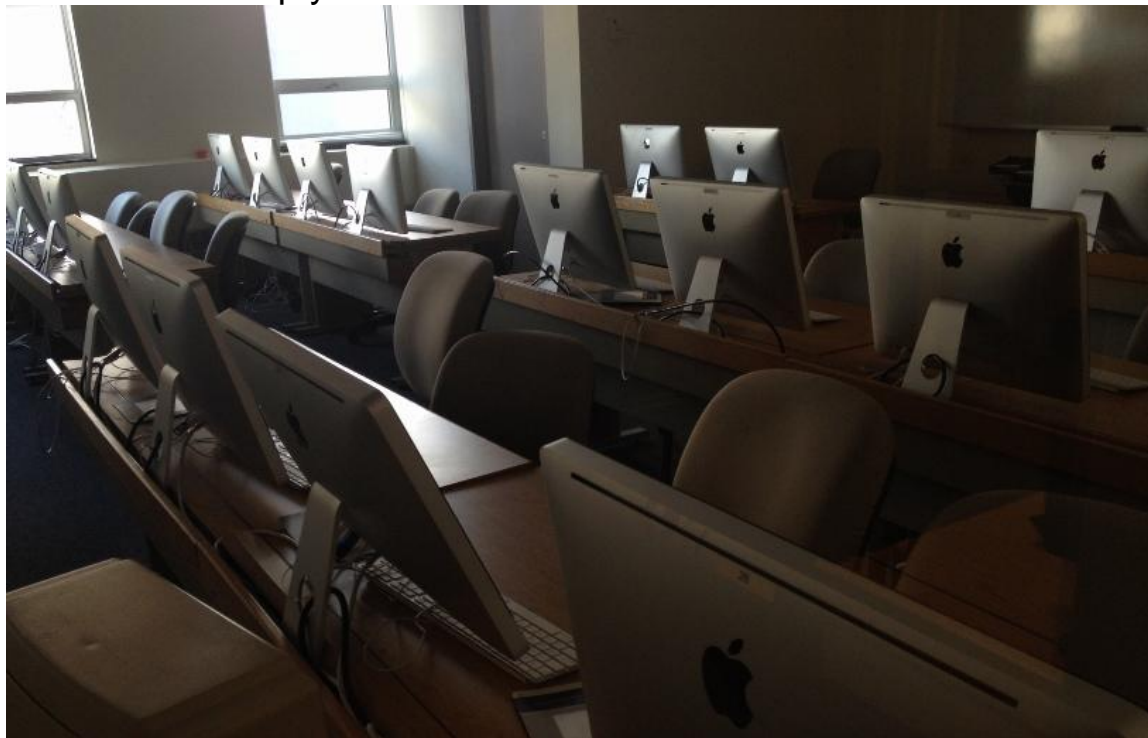
Participants should bring their own gear (camera, microphone, editing etc.) Curry College is making their Mac Lab available with FCP 7 and Adobe Premiere as an option.
